## **SEEING THE UNSEEN**

**We fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen.**

—2 Corinthians 4:18

“Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal” (2 Cor 4:16–18). Things of this world—things that are seen—have their day and cease to be. Things of heaven—things that are unseen—last forever.

Obsession with visible things of the world is dropping anchor in unstable mud. Moses dropped anchor in solid soil: “he persevered because he saw him who is invisible” (Heb 11:27).

With the unseen eternal in view, every passing year brings us nearer to death but closer to heaven.

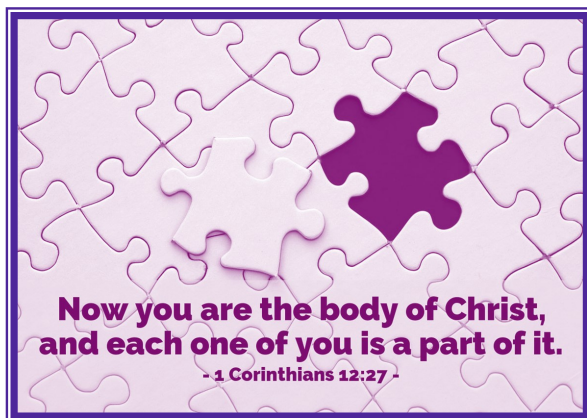
**(Romans 3:23)** For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

**(Ephesians 4:4)** There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

**(Ephesians 2:14)** For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;

**(Galatians 3:27)** For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. **(28)** There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

**(Romans 12:15)** Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.



## HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16).
