Rise, let us go! Matthew 26:46

Crushed with anguish over his approaching crucifixion, Jesus stumbled deeper into Gethsemane to pray. "Stay here and keep watch with me," he implored his three best friends. And three disappointing times, he came back to find them sleeping instead of watching. Feelings of sorrow and shame must have been devastating when those friends later thought about that night. They had failed him, who had never failed them.

We know the feeling, don't we? Gut-wrenching grief over having been unfaithful to him, who has never been unfaithful to us. But listen to his merciful, understanding voice as he says to you what he said to them. "Rise, let us go!" In other words, let's move on. You made a mistake. You can't change that. It's okay. Put it behind you. You'll do better next time.

HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for us and rose from the dead, making salvation available as a gift (John 3:16; Romans 6:23). In order to benefit from this great sacrificial love, one must receive God's grace through faith in Christ and obedience to him (Romans 5:1-2; Hebrews 5:9). To become a Christian, the Bible teaches that we must believe in and put our trust in Christ (John 8:24), turn away from a life of sin (Luke 13:3), confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16). Main Text: **(1 Corinthians 15:1-11)**

Supporting Text:

(Titus 1:11) Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake.

(Colossians 2:8) Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

(1 John 4:1) Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

(2 Corinthians 12:12) Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds.

(Isaiah 7:14) "Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel."

(Isaiah 53:5) But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. **(6)** All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

(Hosea 6:2) After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight.

(Galatians 2:4) And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage: **(5)** To whom we gave place by subjection, no, not for an hour; that the truth of the gospel might continue with you.

(John 20:28) And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.

(James 1:18) Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

(1 Timothy 1:13) Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief.
